Advancing Urban-Rural Linkages: Culture, Housing and Basic Services

I. Background

In May 2019, the People's Government of **Songyang County, China**, participated in the **First Session of the United Nations Habitat Assembly**, whereby a **Letter of Intent on Cooperation** was signed with the United Nations Human Settlements Programme (UN-Habitat). Songyang was one of three entities from China, and the **only county-level government** represented at the Assembly. Since then, Songyang County has convened the *Forum on Urban-Rural Linkages* on a biannual basis - in 2019, 2021, and 2023 - providing an international platform for dialogue, knowledge exchange and partnership building.

These forums contribute to the advancing of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, the New Urban Agenda, and UN-Habitat's strategic plan priorities- by showcasing inspiring innovative practices that align with the Guiding Principles

for Urban-Rural Linkages, and strengthening partnerships to foster more balanced and inclusive territorial development.

In recent years, guided by China's leadership and vision, Songyang has fully implemented national and local policies. Following the strategy of "making full use of eight advantages and implementing eight major measures," Songyang has advanced development and modernization, and promoted the concept of "a people's city built by the people and for the people." Songyang has made ceaseless efforts to establish itself as a model county for "harmonious integration of heritage and modernity," narrated compelling stories about its people-centered urban development, and created the image of "*Mystical Songyang: Homeland of Ideals*".

ABOUT SONGYANG

Geographic location southwest of Zhejiang Province, China, under the administration of Lishui City

*Songyang has established itself as a **model county for Harmonious integration of heritage and modernity***



Songyang has been designated as a provincial pilot city for urban renewal, a national pilot county for cultural industry-driven rural revitalization, a pilot county for intelligent and connected transportation within Zhejiang’s modern transportation industry, and a provincial demonstration county for attracting university students back to work in the county. A total of 78 villages in Songyang have been listed as Traditional Chinese Villages, and the county has made outstanding progress in implementing the initiative of “Saving Old Houses to Empower Rural Revitalization.” The International Dialogue on Urban-Rural Linkages 2025 will showcase Songyang’s inspiring success in modernization to an international audience.

Through field visits and case studies, the conference will demonstrate the region’s efforts on reducing urban-rural disparities with a focus on culture, housing and basic services, to illustrate settlement patterns in one of China’s mountainous areas.

Ultimately, the conference aims to contribute to coordinated, sustainable county-level urban-rural development while fostering cross-regional cooperation and exchange, thereby amplifying the global understanding of Chinese-style modernization and the concept of shared prosperity.

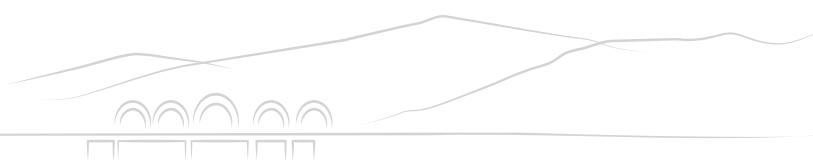
